Sr. Mary's primary ministries have been nursing and chaplaincy. She studied nursing at Seattle University and completed chaplaincy training at Sacred Heart Hospital in Spokane. She's worked as a nurse at Holy Family Hospital, Pondera County Hospital in Conrad, Montana, Mt. Carmel in Colville and St. Joseph's in Chewelah. She retired in 2008 as director of pastoral care at St. Joseph's Hospital and long-term care. Her home parish is Guardian Angel, Power, in the Helena Diocese. Sr. Mary celebrated her 60th Jubilee in Sinsinawa, WI on June 3rd.
