Although the Collection supports national ministries, the Diocese of Spokane receives meaningful grants from both Catholic Home Missions and Black and Native American Missions. These grants support different ministries at the local level.

Sacred Heart taking Yard Sale Donations

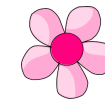

Holy Ghost Parish will have their monthly potluck breakfast on Sunday, May 19th after the 8 am mass. Please bring something to share!

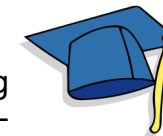


Confirmation/First Communion Mass—Friday, May 31st
