Stewardship Sunday—Sept. 15th

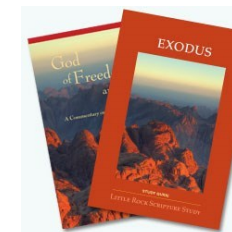
