Stewards of Treasure

The biblical principle for being a good steward of our treasure is that we tithe the first 10% of all that God gives to us. Christians have traditionally divided that amount in half with 5% going to the Church and 5% to all other charities. An important part of being a good steward is that our response to God is prayerfully planned. Pull out a calculator and plan on taking a step in faith. If you are giving at 1.1% and find the idea of 10% overwhelming, then simply take a baby step forward with the goal of increasing over time. Always keep in mind that God will never be outdone in generosity.
