### Coronavirus Precautions

To minimize the opportunities for transmission of the COVID-19 Virus our parishes will be observing the following precautions:

1. Abstain from shaking hands or touching at the Sign of Peace and the Our Father.
2. The Celebrant will wash his hands before distributing Communion.
3. Communion will only be given in the hand—not on the tongue.
4. Please cough into your sleeve, not your hand.
5. Holy Water Fonts have been drained. Continue making the Sign of the Cross as you enter the church.
6. If you have flu-like symptoms, especially with accompanying headaches, refrain from attending Mass. Note, however, that carriers of the coronavirus may be symptom-free!

**Baptism of children:** Please call to schedule instruction and a date for the baptism.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Please call the office if you or someone you know is sick.

**Marriage:** Schedule an appointment with the pastor at least 6 months prior to setting a wedding date.
