Weeds! Weeds!

They seem to do so well! They do not need to be nurtured or fussed over like crops, flowers or shrubs. They look healthy and flourish.

Why is that? There will always be weeds around. In today's Gospel from Matthew, Chapter 13, Jesus explains in this parable:

“While everyone was asleep his enemy came and sowed weeds all through the wheat, and then went off. When the crop grew and bore fruit, the weeds appeared as well.

The slaves of the householder came to him and said,

‘Master, did you not sow good seed in your field?

Where have the weeds come from?’

He answered, ‘An enemy has done this.’

His slaves said to him,

‘Do you want us to go and pull them up?’

He replied, **‘No, if you pull up the weeds you might uproot the wheat along with them.**

Let them grow together until harvest.”

Jesus waits until harvest. He shows such patience and compassion. He gives everyone every possible opportunity to become good seed. Jesus showers His gifts on the good and bad alike. He waits. His wisdom is such an inspiration to us. He tells us not to let evil defeat us. Instead, defeat evil with good. We are tempted to seek revenge or restitution. Jesus opened his arms on the cross instead of destroying us. **So, here's the lesson in all this: No one needs love more than someone who does not deserve it. If we wait around until people “deserve” love, we will be waiting around for the rest of our lives. We choose not to be conquered by evil. We don't have the strength to do that on our own. We need Jesus Christ. We need strength and grace that comes from the Eucharist and the other Sacraments. Jesus conquered the cross. We are invited to carry our crosses and follow the example of Christ. Weeds are there. Let us always choose to be the good seed of the Kingdom of God!**
