A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



“My God, My God, Why Have You Forsaken Me?”

We all have felt moments like this. We may have felt abandoned. Where is God in all this? **Why isn't He here to help me in my struggles, pain or grief? Where is He?** At moments like this, we feel so alone. We experience the pain of loneliness.

A world-famous psychiatrist called loneliness one of the most devastating diseases of **our age. It just doesn't happen in “dark days,” but in the midst of a crowd or on a beautiful summer day.** It can unexpectedly happen anytime and anywhere.

A well-known actress was attending a Good Friday Liturgy and listening to the **“Passion of Our Lord.”** She had been suffering from terrible pain in her abdominal region. She went to doctors and even insisted on having exploratory surgery to find the cause. Physically, she was in good health. **It wasn't until the reading of the Passion of Our Lord when Jesus says, “My God, My God, Why have You forsaken Me?” that she found the answer.** Her pain was not physical. It was spiritual. She says she was lonely for the Love of God! She realized that Jesus understood her pain. **She felt God's soothing presence. She was at peace. God was there for her.**

During Holy Week, we reflect on what Jesus did for us. He humbled Himself. He did not strike back at those who attacked Him! He was mistreated, made fun of and died for us. He even forgave those who made fun of **Him when He was dying on the Cross!** **“Father, forgive them; they do not know what they are doing.”** What a deep love that is! Jesus loves us so much and would do anything for us! He went to the Cross. He forgives us. He gives us new life.

So, in the midst of our pain, we can be comforted knowing that Jesus has not abandoned us. He is there for us! In gratitude, let us be present to Him. The gift that comes to us is Easter joy! So let us respond to Jesus Christ. The Church invites us to participate in the beautiful, inspiring liturgies of Holy Week: Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday.

We are not alone. We are not abandoned! We anticipate, with hope, the joy of Easter.

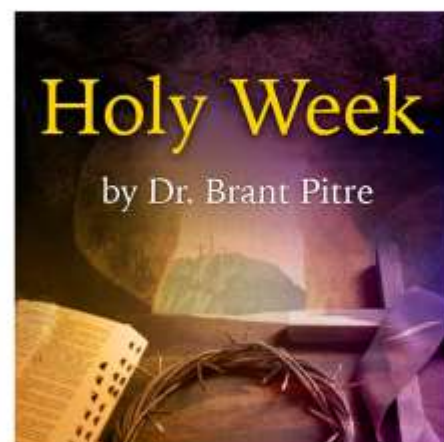

Sacred Relics Of The Saints: Treasures Of The Church - The Cathedral of St. Mary presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on Friday April 30 at 6:30 pm. Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross will be here with an extraordinary Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. There will also be a portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. Throughout history, many healings have been worked in the presence of relics; and many have been come about through this ministry. Do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members, which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.

FT Religious Education/Youth Discipleship Coordinator

Holy Spirit Catholic Church, Fargo, North Dakota, is looking for a full-time Religious Education/Youth Discipleship Coordinator (RE/YD). Responsibilities would include organizing and coordinating RE/YD programs for ages 6-18 to support families in passing on the Faith to their children. The position includes sacramental preparation for Reconciliation, Confirmation, and First Eucharist for children. These responsibilities are executed with a view towards Jesus' call to "go and make disciples of all" (Mt 28:19), and as a member of a staff team committed to missionary discipleship.
