## A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



### Daily Bread West

Our parish has served the hungry of our community for decades! I am so impressed with the commitment and dedication of so many to make this possible.

Churches United has arranged to provide perishable foods, fresh vegetables, meat, bread, and pastries to us as we serve those in need.

Twice a week, we have between 115 to 125 families served as they pick up their food baskets.

This ministry has grown to such an extent that our Bus Barn can no longer meet the needs of this impressive program. The distribution of food had to expand into the garage stalls area. This has limited our own use for the Bus Barn. JPII Schools asked to store two buses in our Bus Barn last winter (January to March), but we had to turn them down. The long lines of cars waiting for their food baskets has created a challenge for school parents as they pick up their children after school.

In April, after reviewing the growing needs of Daily Bread West as well as our own needs, I asked Daily Bread West to move to a new location effective August 1, 2021. I received the approval of the Parish Council regarding this decision.

Churches United is in the process of finding a new location to continue their wonderful program of feeding those in need in our community.

I am grateful to Jackie Schindler and the countless volunteers who donate several hours each week with food distribution. I am thankful for our parish for their strong support of this program over the years. May God bless all who have provided food for the hungry.
