A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



Amazing Grace!

We are very familiar with this hymn. It was written by John Newton, the son of an English sea captain. John traveled the seas with his dad. But he left the ship and ended living a wild life. After a period of time, he became a captain of a cargo ship carrying slaves to America. He did not worry about whether what he was doing was right or wrong. It was a way to make a living.

A violent storm erupted at sea. The cargo ship was being tossed about. All on the ship were in a panic. John turned to God. He had not done that since he left his father's ship. He prayed this prayer, "God, if you will only save us, I promise to be your slave forever." The ship survived.

John Newton kept his promise and became an ordained minister. One of the hymns he composed was "Amazing Grace!" John experienced dangers, toils and fears. So do we.

This story sounds familiar. Today's Gospel is about the disciples' boat being tossed about in a storm. Those on board were frightened. They woke Jesus up and asked him if He cared that they were about to perish. Jesus calmed the storm. Jesus asked His disciples, "Why are you terrified? Do you not yet have faith?"

We experience fear. We face toils and dangers, too. Christ is there to save us. Let us place our trust in Him. He gives us what we need. He asks us to turn our lives over to Him. He will calm our fears. He will encourage us. He is there for us.

Let us call upon the Lord, not only in times of danger or fear, but always! We place our trust in Him. When we do so, we are filled with joy and peace!

There will be two sessions per week, and take place in the Multipurpose Room. Wednesdays at 7pm and Thursdays at 10:30am.

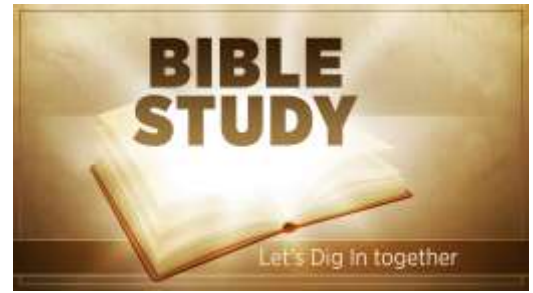
