A MESSAGE FROM FATHER



Does this shock you?

These words were spoken by Jesus when He told His disciples that they must eat His Flesh and drink His Blood. Imagine how they reacted when they heard this for the first time! I would think they would have been beyond belief.

It still ignites a strong reaction for some, even to this day. When we come to Mass, we have the privilege and gift of receiving the actual Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. It is not a symbol. It is not a representation. It is the actual Body and Blood of Christ! What a gift!

Some of Jesus' disciples could not handle this. Many of His disciples left Jesus. They returned to their former ways of life.

Jesus asked The Twelve if they also wanted to leave. Simon Peter spoke up. He said, "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God."

What a profession of faith! They persisted in their belief. They trusted in the Lord. There are times in our lives that we are pushed to the wall. We are ready to quit. There are times when we need to hold on to something as a way to cope. We need to focus on Jesus Christ. He is our Guide. He is our Strength.

The Apostles were severely challenged by what Jesus said. There were two ways to respond: to leave and return to a former way of life because this was too difficult to accept; or remain faithful to Christ. They chose to keep their focus on Christ.

Let this be an inspiration to us when we face those difficult moments in our lives. Let us look to the Apostles to be inspired by what they did. They "held on" to their faith. Let us do the same. The result of this is God's gifts to us beyond our imagining!
