Baptismal Certificates:

All students enrolled in our RE Program please remember to provide a copy of your Baptismal Certificate. We must have this on file in order for your child(ren) to attend class. Please call the Church of your child's child's Baptism, if not Baptized at St. Peter Church, for this certificate. Any student new to our RE program needs to fulfill this requirement.

Sacramental Preparation:

Students receiving the sacraments of First Communion or Confirmation are required to be involved in Religious Education Classes for one full year prior to receiving the sacrament. First Communion and Confirmation students are required to attend sacramental classes in addition to the Family Catechesis classes. Children who make First Reconciliation/Communion are encouraged to stay involved in our Program and in parish life as preparation for Confirmation.
