As a student preparing for Confirmation, your mission is to compose a letter to our Pastor, Fr. Ruben Herrera, requesting the Sacrament of Confirmation. The purpose of this letter is to express in your own words, your thoughts and feelings about receiving the sacrament. It should be personal and reflective.

This will give you an opportunity to really think about why you are making the decision to get confirmed!

Below are some ideas of topics you may wish to include. Look into your own heart and be sincere when writing your letter. The topics below are only suggestions! Do not use the questions word for word, make the letter your own work.

- *Why do I want to be confirmed?*
- *Why do I consider the sacrament important to my spiritual life?*
- *What new responsibilities and privileges will be mine as a Confirmed Catholic?*
- *How will the “gifts of the Holy Spirit” help and strengthen me?*
- *How will I use my gifts and talents to serve the Church?*
- *Is there an event or individual that has been helpful to you on your faith journey?*

This is a formal letter to be written in ink or typed. The “Letter Requesting Confirmation” is due no later than **September 5, 2021.**
