Virtus is Latin for excellence, valor, moral strength and courage – the same Christian values and virtues we wish to develop in our children, as well as to see practiced by the adults who interact with them as they protect children from abuse of any sort (physical, sexual, emotional maltreatment or neglect of a child). As the primary educator of children, parents have a duty to provide formation related to these Christian values and virtues that are appropriate to each child's developmental level. This same Christian responsibility extends to those catechists who, as extended members of your children's family of faith, serve your children in the religious education classrooms.

In an effort to assist the parents and catechists in this monumental role of protecting youth, the Fort Worth Diocese of the Catholic Church provides materials to be used in collaboration between parents and catechists, who serve as lesson leaders, in establishing safety guidelines and principles for the home, classroom, as well as for other environments in which children might find themselves. All materials are designed so that the catechists or caring adults become partners with parents to ensure that the children and youth are protected and have the necessary tools they need to protect themselves.

A copy of the ***“Teaching Boundaries and Safety Guide”*** document that outlines uniform messages children need to hear from both the parents, catechists and caring adults, **is included as a part of the registration packet**. It is our hope that you will review the ***“Teaching Boundaries and Safety Guide”*** document with your child so that you can reinforce the content at home, which will also be taught in the Religious Education classroom by the catechist. We also have a **form available**, which is **printed on goldenrod colored-paper, which you may request from the Director of Religious Education or the Coordinator of Youth Ministry** to be completed **if you choose to “opt out” of the annual training session** that the catechists will be conducting in the classroom. To “opt out”, you must **sign and return the form to Anne Poplin, the Director of Religious Education, prior to the scheduled training date, which is listed on the opt-out form**. Although you can opt-out of the training, **we highly recommend this training session so that your children and others in the classroom have a clear understanding of safe behaviors and appropriate interactions with adults and other children that reflect Christian-based values and virtues**.

Please note that simply requesting the “opt-out” form is only the first step. **If you request the “opt out” form, but do not sign and return it to the DRE, we will assume your child is to receive the training along with the other students on the date the training is conducted in their Religious Education Classroom.**

Prior to 2021-22, Diocesan Form A and Form B were only required for Youth in Grades 7 – 12. However, if you are enrolling more than one child, you will need to pick up additional copies of the two (2) forms for each of your children. Even though the name of the form still says “Youth” rather than “Children and Youth”, it must be completed for each enrollee.

FORM A: Form A — Annual Youth Ministry Parental Liability Waiver, Permission and Medical Information

FORM B: Form B — Consent to Participate, Code of Conduct, and Consent for Emergency Medical Treatment

This packet is not complete without a copy of both form for each of your children that you are enrolling. Forms A and B must be submitted prior to attendance.
