You will be required to read : "Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing" by Judy Blume . There is a set of questions attached after these directions. Please print the packet and complete it. It will be due on the first day of school.

In addition you will be required to work on the IXL website. You already have a username and password. Please work in the diagnostic tab for 20 minutes each week In addition to the diagnostic, you must complete the IXL Summer Boost Skill plan - Math 4th and Language Arts 4th grade. These programs are for 3rd graders going into 4th. Each plan is 4 weeks long and you can complete it any time over the summer. Click on the skills plan at the top and then click on Summer Boost to choose 4th grade plan. You must change the subject at the top to get both programs. When this work is complete I will be able to develop a personalized skill for your child in order to meet his or her individual needs. IXL provides a weekly report that shows detailed information for each student. All questions they complete are recorded and it shows the amount of time they have actively spent completing tasks. Please note, you should be at a level of 400 as a rising 4th grader. If you are having trouble with your username and password, please email me at bmullins@sj-school.org .
