



## Vocation Poster Contest Q &A

### **What are the dimensions of the poster?**

Posters should be no smaller than 8.5 x11 and no larger than 11” x 17.”

### **What type of art medium may be used?**

All posters should be hand-drawn which consists of artwork that uses pencil, paint, markers, crayons, etc.

### **What should be included in the poster?**

Students are encouraged to use Scripture verses, slogans, catchy phrases, or other words to highlight the promotion of vocations.

### **How will the poster be judged?**

Below is a rubric which teachers/catechist can use to give their students a grade. Judges of the contest will base winners on creativity, craftsmanship, effort, overall vocation message, and overall appearance of the poster.

### **How do we submit entries?**

To submit the posters, email them to the Regional Vocation Director the link of the shared folder to the Regional Vocation Director as noted on the contact page. Please make sure that each entry has the name, school, and grade of the student on the back of the poster. Winning posters will be given back to the student on the day of the awards luncheon. All others will be returned to the school.

### **When are the posters due?**

All entries must be submitted by Friday, December 10th to the Regional Vocation Director.

### **When will we find out the winners?**

Announcements of winners will take place by the end of January.
