



For the next 40 days fellow Christians will do their part to stem the scourge of abortion. Park your car at St. Catherine of Siena Catholic Church, 2340 Hurontario St. (free parking)

- Enter the north side-entrance of St. Catherine of Siena Church (well marked)
- Sign-in using the sign-in sheets at the information table (hand sanitizer on site)
- Grab a sign from the box to the right to the table (return the sign to the box upon your return from the site)
- Walk south on Hurontario and walk west on Queensway towards the hospital
- 5 minute walk to the Vigil Site on the south side of Queensway Blvd. (50 paces west of Confederation Parkway) south sidewalk/pathway and pray near the grey candy cane shaped vent stack and over by the metal handrail
- Bear silent witness for one hour, pray alone or pray with a group
