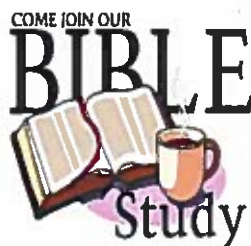


Epic Church History Study – All are invited to join us for an in depth look at our Church over the

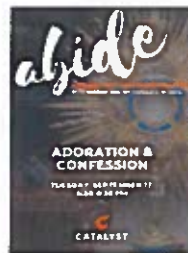
