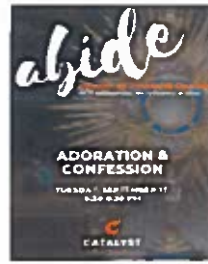
Upcoming High School Retreat for Confirmation Candidates that cannot attend our retreat.
