Service Ministry Update for Nov. & Dec:

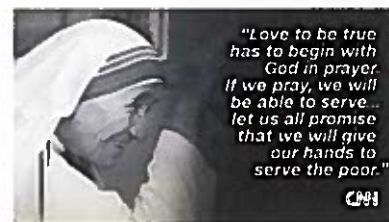
\$2,562.02 was spent on various needs of 14 households

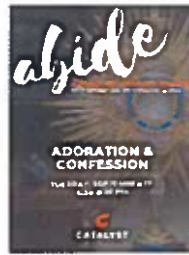

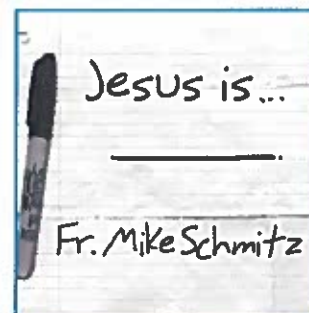
