Question of the Week for the 2nd Sunday of Lent:

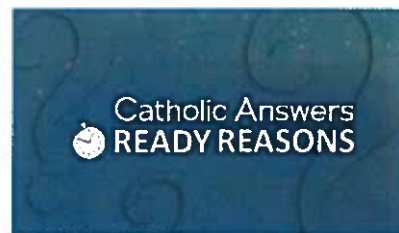
Question for Children: Share about a time when you felt especially close to God or Jesus.
