**A message from the St. Michael Finance Chair** - Fellow parishioners, please be mindful that during this trying time of the COVID – 19 Pandemic, our parish expenses continue. We understand that this has created financial strife for many of us. If you are able, please mail your contributions to the Parish Office. Additionally, you can set up automatic withdrawals from your financial institution. Contact the parish office to set up the process. The monthly withdrawal will occur on the second Tuesday of each month. Those of us 70 and a half or older, have the option of making a tax-free contribution from their 401K to the church from their required yearly distribution. Have your financial institution make the check payable to St. Michael Catholic Church. The advantage to this process is that no taxes are withheld from the contribution. The disadvantage is that since no taxes were paid the donation is not deductible for tax purposes. I personally have used both the First Harrison automatic deduction and the contribution from my 401K. Thank you for your support of OUR parish during the bad times as well as the good times. **Watching Mass at Home** – Many of us enjoy watching “mindless” TV from time to time. We have found ourselves passively watching the images in front of us. When it comes to watching Mass from home let us actively participate. Here are a few practical tips:

1. Get Ready: If you are able read the readings before Mass begins.
2. Silence is Golden. Quiet yourself and your surroundings.
3. Call to mind your intentions. If you are with your family voice those out loud. Don't forget those who are sick and for the health care workers that care for them.
4. Participate! Answer the prayers. Sit, stand, and kneel if you are able. Pray along!

**Spiritual Communion** – When you cannot receive the Eucharist physically, we can always receive spiritual communion:

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

**Question for Youth:** Today begins the holiest week of the year. It is a once-a-year opportunity to really reflect on Jesus life, death, and resurrection. How will you enter into this experience? How will you be open to how you might be changed?

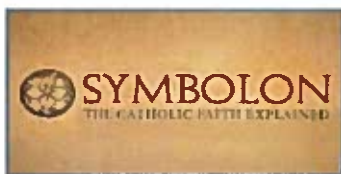
