**Registering in the Parish of Saint Edward**

The law of the Church defines a parish as a definite community of the Christian faithful established on a stable basis within a [Diocese]. The pastoral care of the parish is entrusted to a pastor as its own shepherd under the authority of the diocesan bishop. The law of the Church also states that a parish is to be territorial and embraces all the Christian faithful within a certain territory [ cc 515, 518]

The certain territory for Saint Edward Parish established at its founding is the area of Palm Beach Island from the north end of the Island south to Sloan’s Curve.

To register as a parishioner of Saint Edward requires residence within its territory.

**First Penance and First Eucharist Programs**

Beginning in the First Grade, children of registered parishioners are to be enrolled in a two- year Parish Religious Education sacramental program. Registered parishioners whose children attend Catholic Grade Schools are to participate in the immediate sacramental preparation programs of the Parish. Please contact the parish office for more information.

**Confirmation Program**

Children of registered parishioners who are to be enrolled as candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation must have been baptized, capable of renewing their Baptismal promises, and properly instructed by participation in the two-year parish program beginning in the seventh grade. The Sacrament of Confirmation is usually scheduled for September, when the candidate is a ninth grader.

**Marriages at Saint Edward Parish**

Saint Edward Parish reserves the celebration of the sacrament of marriage to registered parishioners who are practicing Catholics and their immediate family members. Registration requires residence within the territory of the parish [ the North End of the Island south to Sloan’s Curve.] New parishioners must be registered for one year before being considered for the scheduling of a marriage.

**Saint Edward Marriage Regulations**

All couples intending to marry at Saint Edward must meet with the pastor. No date is promised or scheduled before this initial meeting with the pastor, who is to assess the freedom to marry of the couple and explain other marriage regulations. Saint Edward Parish is not a destination site for marriage and Saint Edward does not rent the Church to non-parishioners for marriage ceremonies.

**The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick**

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick can be administered to the sick after the age of reason when the person begins to be in danger due to sickness or age. It is preferred that the sacrament be administered when the person is in control of their faculties.

Today the Church celebrates the Sixth Sunday of Easter!

We continue to have private Masses for our churches are closed, but we join in prayer asking God's help in this difficult time of Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

Our Gospel passage from John 14: 15 -21 reminds us that to love Jesus means to trust him. And that means that we trust his radical teaching about an ideal of unselfish loving. Those who think this is dangerous foolishness belong to the "world," which is interested only in self-promotion and self-protection. The secular ideal is to take care of oneself first, and to think of others later...which too often means not at all.

This is the love we are all called to especially during the pandemic.

Jesus knows that his teaching seems unpromising and so he sends to those who try to be unselfish an Advocate who is the "Spirit of truth." This divine Spirit will be present to our inmost being and will assure us that the path traced out by Jesus will in fact lead to freedom and joy. This powerful Spirit will also guide us in knowing how to love properly in all the circumstances of our lives.

The Spirit will convince them that they are with Jesus, and therefore with the Father. For "... whoever loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and reveal myself to him."

Our second reading for this Sunday, the First Letter of Peter, assures us to: "*Sanctify Christ as Lord in your heart. Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope but do it with gentleness and reverence*" (1 Pet 3:15-16).

It is our life long task to move forward in faith, sustained and renewed by the gifts of the Holy Spirit, "*the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept...but you know him, because he remains with you, and will be in you*" (John 14:17). Through the intercession of Saints Philip, Peter, and John and moved by the presence of the Holy Spirit may we "always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks us for a reason for our hope" (1 Pet 3:15).
