Registering in the Parish of Saint Edward

The law of the Church defines a parish as a definite community of the Christian faithful established on a stable basis within a [Diocese]. The pastoral care of the parish is entrusted to a pastor as its own shepherd under the authority of the diocesan bishop. The law of the Church also states that a parish is to be territorial and embraces all the Christian faithful within a certain territory [cc 515, 518]

The certain territory for Saint Edward Parish established at its founding is the area of Palm Beach Island from the north end of the Island south to Sloan’s Curve.

To register as a parishioner of Saint Edward requires residence within its territory.

First Penance and First Eucharist Programs

Beginning in the First Grade, children of registered parishioners are to be enrolled in a two- year Parish Religious Education sacramental program. Registered parishioners whose children attend Catholic Grade Schools are to participate in the immediate sacramental preparation programs of the Parish. Please contact the parish office for more information.

Confirmation Program

Children of registered parishioners who are to be enrolled as candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation must have been baptized, capable of renewing their Baptismal promises, and properly instructed by participation in the two-year parish program beginning in the seventh grade. The Sacrament of Confirmation is usually scheduled for September, when the candidate is a ninth grader.

Marriages at Saint Edward Parish

Saint Edward Parish reserves the celebration of the sacrament of marriage to registered parishioners who are practicing Catholics and their immediate family members. Registration requires residence within the territory of the parish [the North End of the Island south to Sloan’s Curve.] New parishioners must be registered for one year before being considered for the scheduling of a marriage.

Saint Edward Marriage Regulations

All couples intending to marry at Saint Edward must meet with the pastor. No date is promised or scheduled before this initial meeting with the pastor, who is to assess the freedom to marry of the couple and explain other marriage regulations. Saint Edward Parish is not a destination site for marriage and Saint Edward does not rent the Church to non-parishioners for marriage ceremonies.

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick can be administered to the sick after the age of reason when the person begins to be in danger due to sickness or age. It is preferred that the sacrament be administered when the person is in control of their faculties.

A Message from the Pastor

The Eighth of May of this year is the 50th anniversary of my Ordination to the Priesthood.

Truly this is a time to thank God and all the people who have been my help and support throughout these fifty years. You our good parishioners of Saint Edward have been a great part of my priestly ministry. As you may remember I arrived at Saint Edward in June of 1992 to serve as Judicial Vicar with residence at Saint Edward. Father Frank [one of my most trusted and good friends] welcomed me to the Parish in June of 1992.

The last twenty- nine years of Priestly Ministry with you at Saint Edward has been a joy and an adventure. With the sudden death of Father Frank on May 12, 2011, I was named Pastor of Saint Edward and was installed as such by Bishop Barbarito on October 30, 2011.

The celebration of my Fifty Year of Ordination will be postponed to a later date because of the pandemic. May Eighth will be a time for me to reflect privately on the many blessings God has given me. Please pray for me and know that you are in my daily prayers.

Many parishioners have asked me "How did you ever become Pastor of Saint Edward. With a twinkle in my eye, I would answer: "because I was good to my mother."

I was born in Freeport, Pa., a small town near Pittsburgh, PA. My Mother, Pia and My Father, Engelbert fell in love, married and raised a family of four boys George, Dennis, Thomas, Gerard and one girl, Cornelia. I attend the local Catholic Parish School, and Town High School, the University of Pittsburgh School of Chemical Engineering. Upon entering the seminary to study for the Priesthood, I attended Saint Mary University, Baltimore Md., Saint Vincent Seminary, Latrobe Pa, and the Catholic University of America, obtaining a Degree in Canon Law.

I served in several parishes in the Diocese of Greensburg, Pa, and was the Secretary to Bishop William Connare for many years until his retirement. I served a Chancellor Judicial Vicar and Vicar General in the Diocese of Greensburg. Along the way I was named Domestic prelate with the title of Monsignor by Pope John Paul II.

With the retirement of Bishop Connare, I was given permission to serve as Judicial Vicar of the Diocese of Palm Beach.

Please know that it is an honor that God has permitted me to serve here at Saint Edward, now my HOME.
