Diocese of Kalamazoo Statement in regards to Michigan State Police executed search warrant, October 3, 2018

KALAMAZOO, Mich.: (October 3, 2018): The Diocese of Kalamazoo released the following statement in regards to today's search warrant executed by the Michigan State Police:

“Today the Attorney General’s office, with the assistance of the Michigan State Police, executed a search warrant for the purpose of obtaining documents from the Diocese. The Diocese of Kalamazoo cooperated fully. This was part of a similar process that took place in all Catholic Dioceses in the State of Michigan, and is part of the Attorney General’s investigation into the handling of clergy sexual abuse allegations dating back to 1950. As we stated previously, the Diocese stands ready to cooperate in any way that will lead to even greater protection and safeguards of all people, particularly for children and vulnerable adults.
