

The Diocesan of Kalamazoo Trauma Recovery Program is seeking to hire licensed mental health clinicians to provide screening and facilitate psychoeducational group sessions (10 weekly sessions per series; the series is offered once or twice per year, depending on location). Group sessions are offered in either English or Spanish, so bilingual clinicians are encouraged to apply.

Prospective candidates must be trained in the Trauma Model (training provided), and must support the teachings of the Catholic Church. Candidates must have a master's degree in psychology, counseling, or social work, and must be licensed to practice psychotherapy in the state of Michigan. Candidates must have at least two years of experience, post-master's degree. Candidates will be required to carry their own liability insurance.

This is a contract position, with a stipend for each series completed, and related assessments for participants.
