Divine Mercy Sunday, the newest feast on the Catholic calendar, was instigated by Pope John Paul II in the year 2000. Coming on the first Sunday after Easter every year it reminds us that the face of God is mercy and that we can always look to the future knowing that our lives and our world are in the hands of a God who governs and acts only with mercy.

This morning as we continue to deal with the Covid-19 pandemic may we find new hope in God's mercy and may the prayer, Jesus I trust in You, not only find a place on our lips but also find a home in our hearts.
