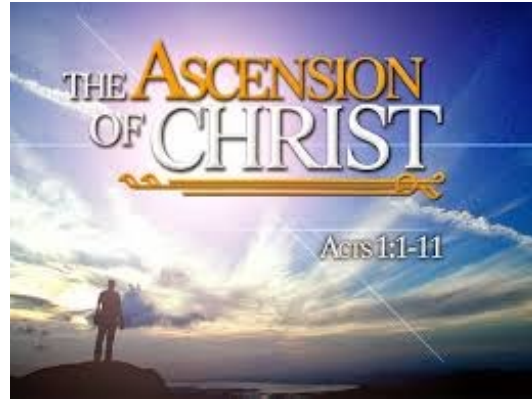

ASCENSION Sunday marks the day that Jesus ascended to heaven and is celebrated on the fortieth day of Easter.

For Jesus and his disciples their encounters were a series of meeting points. They happened on the seashore, in towns and villages, on the plains, on the road, in people's houses, in the Garden of Gethsemane, on the mountaintop. They took many different forms and involved many others.

These meetings continued to occur after the Resurrection until the return of Jesus to his Father, his ultimate meeting point. In returning to his Father, Jesus gives a mission and a promise. A mission to preach the Good News of God's love, hope and peace, to be living witnesses of his presence.

In our own lives too there are many meeting points; many occasions or gatherings. They are times to pause, to reflect, to celebrate, to be drawn together and united and to recognize his presence in our gatherings.

So then, like the disciples, let us not be looking upwards to heaven. He is here within and among us. He walks and talks with us. His promise is 'And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time.'
