Opening Prayer – Fr. Tom

Agenda Items:

PAC Membership – Fr. Tom has asked current PAC representatives to consider extending their PAC service for an extra year. All PAC members will remain on the council for an additional year.

Financial update – Faith Direct is up 2% we are at 90% of our YTD budget. We have postponed many projects and moved them to next year. Collections are up from last month. Parishioners are sending in their envelopes. PPP loan has helped and we will continue to do the necessary paperwork for the loan to be forgiven. So financially we are doing ok.

Meeting room & events – we will put the booking of rooms on hold until late August. Parish and sacramental life will continue. RE English and Span. 1<sup>st</sup> Communion have been scheduled for June 27<sup>th</sup> and SJS 1<sup>st</sup> Communion is scheduled for August 29<sup>th</sup>. Meeting rooms will be booked with priority given to SJS and RE classes first. All meeting rooms are closed until August 31<sup>st</sup>.

St. Joseph Catholic School – working on next year's plan – not sure how it will look in August but we have Plans A, B & C which we will utilize once we see what FCPS, Governor of VA, CDC and the Office of Catholic Schools advises. We currently have 516 students enrolled for next year. We are still accepting applications for the grades that are currently not to capacity. We will have confirmations in the Fall and we will continue 2 years preparation for Confirmation.

Update on Reintegration at SJC – it seems to be going smoothly. Phase 2 involves every other pew and seems to be working well. Mass attendance is still currently lower than our capacity so at this point that is good. Phase 3 we will be able to have more parishioners at mass. Our max at this point is 250 parishioners but if there are families sitting together we may be able to go a little bit higher because they can sit together. The Church ventilation system has been adjusted to maximize flow of outside air which has not negatively affected cooling or comfort level. Right now the 5:00p.m. Saturday evening mass is streamed live and can be watched on Sundays as well. There is no singing due to the CDC and medical advisors so we will continue with no singing and just instrumental music. We will continue to keep doors open to help with the ventilation. We need to have a Mask Mandatory for the Parish office. Jeanne will work on this.

Phase 3 and Phase 4 – Baptisms will be at 11:00 a.m. on Saturdays. Confessions are on Wednesday at 8:40 a.m. and by appointment only. Confessions are in the cry room and the groom's room, and seems to be working. We maintain 6 feet distance and the confessor stands

so there is minimal cleaning involved. There has been 15 – 20 confessions a week and about 15 – 20 appointments as well.

Revised Weekend Mass Schedule for the future weekends - We will have a revised mass schedule for the future and into 2021. 5:00p.m. Saturday, Sundays 7:00a.m., 9:00a.m., 11:00 a.m. 1:00p.m., Spanish 3:00p.m. and 5:00p.m.. This revision eliminates one Mass on Sunday morning, and is in response to recent data on Mass attendance and parish census. Also, having 7 weekend Masses brings SJC more in line with other parishes. This revised schedule has been approved by the Diocese. The new schedule will be effective post COVID and once SJC fully re-opens.

There were no emails received this month.

Next Meeting – we will make a decision at a later date to see if we need to meet in July virtually.
