Grade	Theme	Project Description
PK & K	Cares for Living Things/God's Creation	The students will be making bird feeders and listen to two speakers- one about caring for dogs and the other about the Oklahoma Humane Society.
1st	Cares about Education/Atrium	Students will work on their education books and work on service projects around the school.
2nd	Cares for the Sick	Students are visiting Mercy Hospital - They will visit the volunteer coordination and pastoral services center.
3rd	Works to End Poverty & Homelessness	Students are visiting the offices of Curbside Chronicle to learn about how this magazine employs and empowers men and women transitioning out of homelessness.
4th	Works to End Hunger	Students will be sorting and weighing food at the Regional Food Bank
5th	Cares for our Older Friends	Playing bingo with the residents at St. Ann's Retirement Center
6th	Respects Ability Awareness	Visiting the Center of Family Love to tour the grounds, play games, karaoke, and do crafts with the residents
7th	Promotes Human & Civil Rights	Students will visit the women and children of Holy Family Home, providing lunch, delivering toiletries, and making Valentines with them.
8th	Supports Veterans & Active Duty Service Members	Students will spend time at the VA hospital learning from veterans who have served our county and spreading some cheer by playing bingo with them.

- Classroom teachers have all the details and safety contact information for the day
- Refer to field trip forms to see if your student needs to pack a lunch that day
