2. St. Margaret's Cemetery, Montgomery, Alabama

A. Hours of Operation

St. Margaret's Cemetery is owned and operated by Catholic Cemeteries, Inc. and is located in the City of Montgomery cemetery, known as Oakwood. The Oakwood Cemetery office is open from 7:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., 7 days a week. The gates to St. Margaret's Cemetery and all other cemeteries in Oakwood Cemetery open at 7:00 a.m. and close at dusk, 7 days a week.

B. Cemetery Fees

C. Interment and Disinterment

1. As part of a long-standing agreement between the cemeteries in Oakwood Cemetery and the City of Montgomery, the City of Montgomery Sexton marks the grave and attends any burial or disinterment in the Oakwood cemeteries. This includes St. Margaret's Cemetery.
2. Any work in St. Margaret's Cemetery must be approved by Catholic Cemeteries, Inc. and the City of Montgomery Sexton.
3. All burials in St. Margaret's Cemetery must abide by Montgomery, Alabama, Municipal Code, Chapter 7 – Cemeteries.
4. Catholic Cemeteries, Inc. has an exclusive contract for opening and closing graves in St. Margaret's Cemetery with Farmer Memorial Company and Funeral Services, LLC. No other company or individual is authorized to open or close a grave in St. Margaret's Cemetery without the written consent of Catholic Cemeteries, Inc.
5. The full-size grave spaces in St. Margaret's Cemetery are approximately 4.5 feet wide by 9.5 feet long. Item D.1(f) of the Rules and Regulations of Catholic Cemeteries, Inc. applies to full-size grave spaces.
6. St. Margaret's Cemetery has grave spaces that are less than 4 feet in length designated specifically for the ground burial of infants and cremated remains. There shall be no more than 1 interment of cremated remains in any grave space less than 4' in length. The infant and cremation lots in the cemetery are for at-need burials, with each burial being in the next available space in the lot as determined by the cemetery or its contractor. Reservation of spaces prior to need shall not be allowed in these lots.

D. Memorials, Foundations and Installation

1. The City of Montgomery Sexton shall have the same duties and exclusions of a contractor for Catholic Cemeteries, Inc. under Item E of the Rules and Regulations of Catholic Cemeteries, Inc.
2. For a grave space in St. Margaret's Cemetery of less than 4 feet in length, that is not designated as an Infant Burial lot, only one standard lawn

level granite, marble or bronze marker not larger than 2' x 1' x 4" is allowed.

3. For grave spaces in any designated Infant Burial lot in St. Margaret's Cemetery, only one lawn-level marker not larger than 8" x 10" x 4" is allowed.
