Home School Requirements: 2020-2021

- All students are required to make the full Prep program payment
- All students are required to attend Sunday Mass & Holy Days of Obligation
- All students are required to follow the Philadelphia Archdiocesan Curriculum guidelines for the appropriate Grade level(s) being taught.
- The Prep Office will supply materials for the students Religious Education.
- The Prep Office will supply guidance to the parent while educating their child.
- Parents are required to attend monthly webinars or meetings to help strengthen their understanding of the faith and be given ways to share this information with their child
- The students will be asked to attend check ins with a Catechists when arranged
- The students are required to complete the E-Assessment at the end of each Chapter
- The students are required to take a mid-year Assessment in December/January
- The students are required to take a final Assessment in May
- The students are required to attend confession with the Prep program during Lent & Advent. A sign up will be sent out when dates are available.
- The students are required to attend an Ash Wednesday Service
- The students may will Research a Saint on their own and hand it into the office during their Mid-year Assessment. (Samples will be sent home)
- The students are required to attend the End of the Year May Procession with the Prep Children.
- An optional Advent & Lent service project will be sent home
