

Family Plug-In Project

Last year, YLT members participated in Parish Plug-In Projects. These projects were meant to help members become more plugged into their parishes by being involved with new ministries. This year, we are focusing on families. Each YLT meeting will have a different theme and focus. Within the month after each meeting, each member will have the opportunity to complete a Family Plug-In Project. At least three projects will need to be completed for consideration for staffing Camp David.

The Family Plug-In Project is simple: the YLT member will lead some activity with other members of his or her family related to the theme of YLT that month. For example, following the session on prayer, a YLT member might gather their family and lead them together in praying the rosary. After the teambuilding session, a YLT member might lead the family in a family game night. Parents and guardians – please be supportive of your YLT member and encourage cooperation from all family members to participate in these activities. Remember, at least 3 projects must be completed to be considered for Camp David staff.

After the project has been completed, please complete the Family Plug-In Project form. If you need ideas about what to do, please don't hesitate to call or email the Office of Youth and Young Adult Ministry.

Forms will need to be turned in before or with the Camp David application (by Friday, March 12th) to be considered for staff.
