

RULES AND GUIDELINES

- Be sure your child has a coat to wear to school for the cold weather days.
- The only sweatshirt that may be worn in the classrooms is the official Assumption sweatshirt.
- Polo shirts must be worn under uniform sweatshirts.
- All articles of clothing must be true to size. No oversized or tight fitting garments allowed.
- Wednesday is Mass Day. Students will be attending Mass at 8:30 a.m. with Assumption Parish; children should be neat and clean.
- It is recommended that shirts are to be worn tucked in at all times.
- When the outdoor weather changes, please make sure your child comes to school prepared for the outdoor elements with coat, jacket, gloves, etc.
- Please label all sweatshirts, vests, coats, mittens, etc. with student's name.

Uniform clothing can be purchased from most any place except for the Girls plaids from Lands End website and the Crewneck and Hooded Sweatshirts and Jackets from Graphic Apparel, 509-525-7630

Bottoms

- Girls Bottoms:
 - Jumpers, Skirts and Skorts: **Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid** ordered from **Lands End**
 - Skirts, Skorts, Pants or Shorts Navy or Khaki
(Skirts, Skorts, or Shorts are not to be longer than the back knee crease and no shorter than three inches above the back knee crease.)
- Girl's Tights and Leggings:
 - Navy Blue, Evergreen, Red, White or Black
(Leggings may be worn under the jumper, skirt, or skort, not alone as pants.)
(No multi-colored/patterned or printed tights or leggings allowed.)
- Boy's Bottoms:
 - Pants or Shorts Classic Navy Blue or Khaki
(Cargos are allowed. No baggy or sloppy look allowed. No strings, ties, etc. from pants or shorts.)

Tops

- Boy's and Girl's Shirts:
 - Polo or Turtleneck Shirts White, Red, Navy or Evergreen
 - Girl's Peter Pan Collar Blouses: White long or short Sleeved. No trim of any kind.
 - Boys Oxford Shirt: White, Short or Long Sleeve Button up shirt
- Boy's and Girl's Cardigans: Navy Button-front V-neck or Zip-front Cardigans
- Boy's and Girl's Polartec Vests: Navy Fleece Vest

Socks

- Boy's and Girl's Socks: **Solid color with small logo only**, White, Red, Navy, Black, Gray or Evergreen

Shoes

- Boy's and Girl's Shoes:
 - **Closed toed only**. No athletic sandals, Birkenstocks, crocs, flip flops, and no cleats worn in the building.

Belts

- Boy's and Girl's Belts:
 - Belts must coordinate with the uniform.

Sweatshirts and Jackets can be ordered from Graphic Apparel

Following items can be purchased at Graphic Apparel online or at the store: Navy Cardigans, Crewneck Sweatshirt, Front Pocket, Hooded Sweatshirt or Zipper Jacket with Assumption School Logo.

K-4 Sweatshirts

- Boys and Girls Sweatshirts: Navy crewneck sweatshirt

5-8 Sweatshirts

- Boys and Girls sweatshirts, Navy front pocket, hooded sweatshirt

K-8 Jackets

- Boys and Girls navy zip jacket

Body Piercing:

- Students choosing to do so may pierce the lobes of the ear only. No other body piercing is acceptable.

Coats/Jackets

- Outdoor jackets or coats may not be worn in the building during the school day.
- Trench coats may not be worn in the school building.

Facial Make-Up:

- It is not encouraged, but if worn it must be lightly and tastefully applied.
- This choice is reserved for the 7th and 8th grade girls only. Body, face, and hair glitter is not to be worn.
- Visible body tattoos (stick-on, etc.) are not to be worn.

Hair:

- Hair must be clean, neatly groomed and out of students eyes.
- Extreme grooming or coloring is not acceptable.
- Emblems, logos, or symbols shaved into the hair are not allowed.

Hats:

- The wearing of hats is not permitted in the school building.
- Headgear must reflect the spirit of the dress code.

Jewelry:

- Jewelry should be worn in good taste and should not be distracting, excessive, inconsistent with our Christian values or inappropriate for school.
- Post earrings and small earrings are acceptable and are to be worn in the lobes of the ears only.
- The use of excessive jewelry, large chain link jewelry, spikes or metal necklaces or bracelets, including chains to hold wallets are not appropriate for school. Jewelry must be removed during Physical Education class.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION DRESS CODE for grades 7-8 only

- T-shirt, loose fitting, no sleeveless shirts
- Shorts: loose fitting, not too short, no tight leggings
- Tennis shoes
- Students must change for PE.
- Students should bring deodorant.

GAME DAY OR EVENT ATTIRE:

- BOYS & GIRLS GRADES K-8 School Spirit T-Shirt must be worn with Khaki or Navy pants, skort or skirt.

DRESS CODE EXCEPTIONS

- Exceptions to the dress code may be determined by the Principal in order to adapt to special events, Free Dress/Spirit T-Shirt Day, or in the event of heating or ventilation emergencies.

FREE DRESS DAYS

- It is our intent that appropriate school attire be worn on free dress days. No holes, tears, or frayed edges are allowed. Shirts must have sleeves. Any clothing or accessories must be consistent with our Christian values and appropriate for school.
- Halter tops, tank tops, spaghetti straps, sleeveless shirts, Bare midriffs, tight-fitting T-shirts are not appropriate.
- Shorts are not to be longer than the back knee crease and no shorter than three inches above the back knee crease.
- No baggy/saggy pants or underwear visible at any time.

THEMED DRESS DAYS

- In addition to Free Dress Days there will be themed dress days. On themed dress days only appropriate themed dress may be worn. If not dressed in the themed attire students must be in uniform dress code. Generally students will not be allowed to wear athletic shorts, sweats or T-shirts on themed dress days.

DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS

- There will be one warning given for uniform violations. Students violating the dress code will be asked to adhere to the dress code which may include a call to parents for a change of clothes.
