

Worship Commission Zoom Meeting April 26, 2021 – 7:00pm

Minutes

In Attendance: Fr. Marc Gawronski, Gregg Zuccker, John Kukla, Donna Plegue, Paul Voreis, Barb Klemans

Fr. Marc began with a prayer at 7:05pm.

- Commission Update:
 - **5/16 – Baccalaureate** – 5:00pm Mass outside, 6:00pm Dinner in Parish Hall, Sacred Heart High School Graduates – Mother Teresa & Fr. McGivney Scholarships will be awarded. Knights are catering. Plated dinners will be served. There are 38 Graduating Seniors in the class of 2021.
 - **5/23 – Confirmation** – 5:00pm Mass outside at Sacred Heart for Sacred Heart, St. Joseph and St. Cyprian churches.
 - **5/30 – World Marriage Day** - 11am Mass, 12:00pm Lunch in Parish Hall, Knights are catering. Plated lunch will be served.
 - **Families of Parishes** - gatherings begin on Wednesday, 4/28 from 7:00pm to 9:00pm. Visit FOPgatherings.org to register and receive the Zoom meeting invitation. “Encountering Jesus Through New Relationships” is the topic. A few days ago 62 people were signed up.
- Fr. Marc’s update on Outdoor Mass and Feast of Corpus Christe:
 - **5:00pm Sunday Outdoor Mass will begin on 5/23** on the front lawn of the Rectory, weather permitting, and in the church if not. If there’s a weather issue with the start date, it will change to 5/30.
 - Outdoor Mass will be completely different than last year. Everything used will be simple and nice. Fr. Marc will check the basement of St. Anne’s for a table, a cross and wood stand for Ambo. The keyboard and speakers will be set up by Kevin and stored at the Rectory. There will be no radio broadcast.
 - Donna, Belinda organize parking and communion. There will be handicap parking spots. Parking will be encouraged in the river lot, next to cemetery, Church Road side of Chapel. Also could park at the north end of Parish offices and walk the trail to front of Rectory.
 - Elderly can sit on the patio with Fr. Marc.
 - Will need at least 6 Eucharistic Ministers .
 - Youngsters can help with hand sanitizer at communion.
 - Rain Plan will be announced on Facebook by 1pm, if there’s a problem.
 - **11:00am Mass on 6/6, Feast of Corpus Christe** will end with Eucharist placed in a Monstrance with procession from the church to the chapel, adoration will be held from 12:00pm to 5:00pm. Chapel doors will stay open to encourage visitors.
- Interfaith / Barb Klemans:
 - Pat and Richard Schmidt recently collected 900 more diapers from the Gathering Space and Parish Office. Our total collection was 23,000 at the end of 2020.
 - Gregg said it’s shocking a family with 1 child pays \$80 a week for diapers. That’s expensive!
 - Donna updated us that Sacred Heart will have another blood drive on June 19th. The goal is to have a blood drive on Grosse Ile every 56 days – that’s how often a person can donate blood. The need is very great. Donna plans

to get our teens involved, they need service hours. Red Cross is also short of volunteers.

- Eucharistic Ministers & Altar Servers / Donna Plegue:
 - Eucharistic Ministers are scheduled through June. They're doing a great job finding their own substitutes.
 - Sent out Altar Server schedule for May/June and 1 family with 2 boys signed up.
 - Fr. Marc mentioned when we can – possibly Fall or Christmas – have families with Altar Servers, serve together.
- Ushers / Gregg and Fr. Marc:
 - Ushers are great. Paul and Gary make sure people are counted as they enter and attendance tracked, not to go over capacity.
- Environment / for Ginger Cortis and Nancy Franzen:
 - From Commission Members - Many comments about how beautiful it's been in the church for Easter Season. Thank you.
 - Kevin changed the fabric over donor plaques. We can't cover the plaques. Fr. Marc believes our plaque is well placed in Sacred Heart.
- The Eagerly Anticipated Creation of a new Ambo!
 - Thank you Doug Cryderman for making a new Ambo that will have a shelf in front for books of Gospels. There's no hurry. Very grateful you're doing it.
