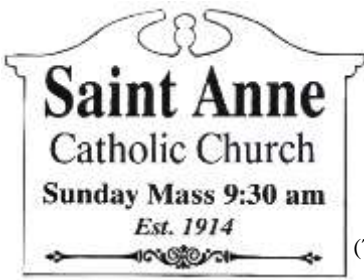

Bishop Poitras will celebrate a Mass for the deceased Bishops, Priests and Deacons on **Thursday, November 5, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.** at Saint-Anthony of Padua Cathedral. All are invited to participate at this celebration.

COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED

A Book is set up at the front of the church for parishioners to write in the names of their departed loved ones. We encourage everyone to come up before Mass or after Mass and write in the names of their loved ones that have passed on. This book will be available for the whole month of November.



November 1, 2020 – The gospel for All Saints Day is always taken from the beginning of Jesus’ Sermon on the Mount where, through the Beatitudes, he introduces his disciples to what it truly means to live in his kingdom. In his apostolic exhortation Rejoice and be Glad. On the Call to Holiness in Today’s World, Pope Francis meditates on each of the Beatitudes individually. He warns us, *“Even if we find Jesus’ message attractive, the world pushes us towards another way of living”* (65).

November 8, 2020 – In today’s parable, the foolish virgins have not brought enough oil to keep their lamps lit, and when the bridegroom finally arrives, they are not waiting joyfully to greet him. As we contemplate the parable we might wonder, what is this oil that keeps the light of Christ alive within us? We might also ponder, is this oil something that another can give to us, or is it something that we must find on our own? We have received the light of Christ in baptism, now our task is to keep it burning brightly until we meet the Lord.

November 22, 2020 – CHRIST THE KING Collection

Again, this year, all of the proceeds for the special Christ the King Collection will be put towards the priests’ retirement fund. The diocese offers a pension of one thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,750) per month to every retired priest. This money is derived from an investment accumulated over the years. However, in the last few years, these funds are just sufficient to generate the money necessary to pay the pension for priests on retirement. Thank you for your donations.

November 1st is [All Saints Day](#)! This ceremonial event is a day that we praise all the saints -- we remember the saints and allow the memory of their faith to spur us on to deeper worship and greater service to the Lord. To honour All Saints Day, please join us in reading or saying this quick prayer:

Dear God, praise you for giving us the glorious example of the Saints. I aspire to meet their company, praising you forever in Heaven. Please help me to follow in their footsteps, and yours, Jesus Christ. Please help me to submit myself to Your call, seeking Your order in all things, just as the Saints did. Please help me to commit myself to Your glory, and to the service of my neighbors. Amen.
