**FOCUS ON THE READINGS: Sunday, November 21<sup>st</sup> :** *Christ's dominion is eternal.*

Today's solemnity, by which we close the liturgical year, reminds us that Christ is king and ruler of all. He is the *firstborn of the dead* in whom all power and authority has been invested. By our baptism we share in that holy and royal identity so that we might witness to his glory and kingship before the world.

Both the first and second readings comment on the kingship of the Lord. And the gospel places Jesus in front of Pilate who asks him if he is "The King of the Jews". The life, death, and resurrection of Jesus testify to this truth, and all who listen to Jesus and commit themselves to his wisdom will belong to the truth and to his kingdom. Pilate can make no sense of this. His world is more concerned with illusions of grandeur than with truth.
