CONNECTING TO THE GOSPEL

In today's gospel, we come to Jesus' first prediction of his passion; revealing an important truth about who 'the Christ' is - one who will undergo suffering and even death in following the will of God. And He warns the disciples of the sacrifices and even suffering that they will find on the way to eternal life. Is it too much of a challenge for them? Do they dare to continue following in his footsteps, knowing where the path will lead them?
