SACRED THAT SURROUNDS US: STOLE



The position of the stole differs from priest and deacons. The priest wears the stole around the neck and over the shoulders (similar to a yoke). It is a sign of priestly authority. The priest will kiss the cross that is embroidered on the stole before putting it on. The color of the stole follows the liturgical calendar. The first use of a stole reports back to the 8th century.
