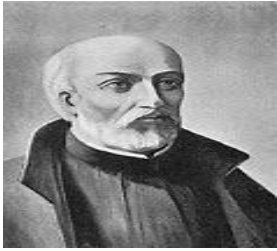

Saint John de Drebeuf was a French Jesuit Missionary who traveled to New France (Canada) in 1625. He worked with the Huron Indians learning their language. He wrote several papers to help the future of missionary work among the Indians. He was captured and killed by the Iroquois in 1649. He is the Patron Saint of Canada.
