Jesus says, “I do will it”. Four small words. “I do” is in our sacred rites and Sacraments. They are action words. “I will it” by Jesus means something happened, something changed; an act of God is accomplished.

### Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent in preparation for the Resurrection of Jesus. Those over 18 and under age 60 are called to fast (taking only 1 complete meal) and abstain (no meat; starting at age 14) on that day. Receiving the Ashes dates back to the second century and is a sign of humility and reminds us we are “dust and to dust you shall return”

Is Ash Wednesday a Holy Day of Obligation? No; but it is a wonderful start to our Lenten Season.
