LITURGY AND LIFE

Today's readings are all about signs. Israel's fidelity to the commandments was the sign that they lived as God's people and that God was with them. Paul proclaims a paradox; the clearest sign of God-with-us is Jesus crucified. In today's Gospel, Jesus is told to produce some sign of his authority to cleanse the temple. His answer baffles the people. *What sign do we give in our homes, places of work, neighborhoods, and Church community that we follow a Lord whose power lies in humility and sacrifice?*

St. Roderick, Martyr

St. Roderick was a priest in Spain during the persecution of the Christian by the Moors. He had two brothers: one a Muslim, one a fallen-away Catholic. St. Roderick attempted to break up an argument between his brothers. They both turned on him beating him unconscious. The Muslim brother then paraded him through the streets proclaiming he had converted to Islam. Regaining consciousness, he proclaimed his Catholic faith for which he was imprisoned and the beheaded.
