Be open to meeting Christ in the person of a stranger along the way.

St. Anselm

St. Anselm was born in Italy in 1033. He became a Benedictine monk, Christian philosopher, and scholar who is recognized for many intellectual accomplishments, especially for his application of reason in exploring the mysteries of faith and definition of theology as “faith seeking understanding.” His highly respected work *Monologium* rationalizes proof of God’s existence. He was made prior of the monastery in 1063 and passed to his heavenly reward in 1109.
