LITURGY AND LIFE

In turbulent times, it can be challenging to truly love those who are different from us, who look different, come from a different country or culture, or hold different political or religious views. Yet Jesus commands us: "love one another." Often we love only when it is easy; Jesus asks us to love when it's hard, just as he did. If we are commanded by Christ to love one another, then contempt or hatred for another is a sin. Is there an individual or group that you find difficult to love? In prayer, ask for God's heart of love and forgiveness. Pray this way each day until you can hold them in God's love. Make an effort to get to know the "other" in your world.

St. Matthias

He was also the man whom early Christians chose to replace one of Jesus Christ's original apostles who betrayed him ~ Judas Iscariot. While preaching the Gospel message, Matthias emphasized the importance of self-control. In order to experience the peace and joy that God intends, Matthias said, people must subordinate their physical desires to their spiritual desires. The physical body is only temporary and subject to many temptations to sin and illnesses, while the spiritual soul is permanent and able to discipline the body for good purposes. Matthias preached that the Holy Spirit will empower people to exercise self-control.
