## LITURGY AND LIFE

While we know the Passion story, it is hard to fully tell it to others because of the deep emotions of unfairness and suffering it evokes. Yet despite how crude a path the story takes us on, it is precisely this willingness by Christ that God expects us to become acutely aware of. Obvious Jesus did not like the persecution and suffering, but He knew the role of love for our salvation. We are invited to embrace and be embraced by Jesus, joining ourselves into union with our own passion story. If we place ourselves on the Cross with Jesus, to look through His eyes, we become part of the glory, energized to proclaim what Jesus has done out of love as we continually participate in that love by being and doing for others.

### Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus – Friday June 11th

In honoring the Sacred Heart, we are honoring the compassion and love of Christ: his human heart, moved with pity for his flock, his divine heart, pierced for the sins of his people. From the heart of Christ, pierced by the soldier's lance, blood and water poured out, "the wellspring of the Church's Sacraments". The First Friday of each month is Devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. First Friday Promises. Those who faithfully complete the First Friday devotion for nine consecutive months are promised the following, as told to Roman Catholic nun St. Margaret Mary Alacoque by Our Lord Jesus Christ: *I will give them all of the graces necessary for their state of life. I will establish peace in their homes.*



### Prayer to The Sacred Heart of Jesus

I fly to Thee Sacred Heart of my Saviour, for Thou art my refuge, my only hope. Thou art the remedy for all my miseries, my consolation in all my wretchedness, the reparation for all my infidelities, the supplement for all my deficiencies, the expiation for all my sins, and the hope and end of all my prayers.

Thou art the only one Who is never weary of me and Who can bear with my faults, because Thou lovest me with an infinite love. Therefore, O my God, have mercy on me according to Thy great mercy, and do with me, and for me, and in me, whatever Thou wilt, for I give myself entirely to Thee, divine Heart with full confidence that Thou wilt never reject me.
