LITURGY AND LIFE

Jesus truly understood his audience. In order to help his avid listeners ponder the Kingdom of God, he used the most familiar images from their everyday environment as doorways into his deeper teachings. Everyone in the crowd in today's Gospel knew the mustard seed to be the smallest of all seeds and how it could grow into a very large bush. Everyone knew the stages of growth of a grain of wheat through to harvest. Jesus led the people from what they already knew about seeds to discover the continuous and wondrous growth of the Kingdom of God. These parables offer us the same proclamation today. Ponder what seed has been planted in you to grow throughout the various seasons.

Saint Anthony of Padua

St. Anthony was born in Lisbon Portugal in 1195. At an early age he was educated in the community of the Canons of the Cathedral of Lisbon. At age 15 he entered the Order of Regular Canons. When the relics of five Franciscan martyrs were brought to Portugal he was inspired to follow in their foot steps and thus transferred to the Franciscan Order. He gave up teaching and devoted himself to preaching. Although he was denied the grace of a martyr's death, he was a martyr of the Word, to the road, and to the crowds. Once he was seen holding the child Jesus in his arms. He died June 13, 1231 and was canonized the following year by Pope Gregory IX.
