LITURGY AND LIFE

Family meals are sacred moments, even between couples. Meals in common signify unity but also are a time to thank God for the blessings of food, both physical and spiritual. As with Elijah, meals strengthen us for mission – so does community life. Before praying over the food, light a candle as a concrete sign of the sacredness of the meal.

Feast of St. Lawrence, Deacon and Martyr – August 10th

Lawrence encountered the future Pope Sixtus II, who was of Greek origin and one of the most famous and highly esteemed teachers. Eventually, both left Spain for Rome. When Sixtus became the Pope in 257, he ordained Lawrence as a deacon, and though Lawrence was still young appointed him first among the seven deacons who served in the cathedral church. He is therefore called "archdeacon of Rome", a position of great trust that included the care of the treasury and riches of the Church and the distribution of alms to the indigent.^[5] When the treasures of the Church were demanded of Lawrence by the prefect of Rome, he brought forward the poor, to whom he had distributed the treasure as alms.^[9] "Behold in these poor persons the treasures which I promised to show you; to which I will add pearls and precious stones, those widows and consecrated virgins, which are the Church's crown."
