St. Bernard Abbot and Doctor of the Church

Born 1090 in France to parents of the highest of nobility. Bernard was highly educated. He desired to excel in literature in order to study the Sacred Scripture. He had a special devotion to the Blessed Virgin and was known for speaking especially sublimely of the Queen of Heaven. After spending over 40 years in cloister and serving several Pope's, he died at the age of 63. During his life he help to found over 163 monasteries spread throughout Europe.
