LITURGY AND LIFE

Today the Letter of James challenges our tendency toward accumulating wealth and our dependence on material items. Materialism is something we all must individually discern about. The reading today helps us to evaluate the importance of “things” in our culture and our own personal lives today. Pope Paul VI called us to live simply so that others might simply live.

Feast of the Holy Guardian Angels Saturday, October 2nd

Devotion to the angels is an ancient tradition which the Christian Church inherited from Judaism. It began to develop with the birth of the monastic tradition. The feast was first kept by the Franciscan order in 1500.^[6] This feast, like many others, was local before it was placed in the General Roman Calendar in 1607 by Pope Paul V. On October 2, 1795, Pius VI granted a partial indulgence every time, with a contrite heart and devotion, any of the faithful say the Guardian Angel prayer. The prayer reads, "Angel of God, my guardian dear, To whom his love commits me here, Ever this day be at my side, To light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen."
