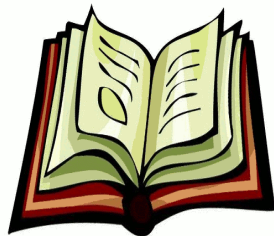

that I shall not be put to shame.**

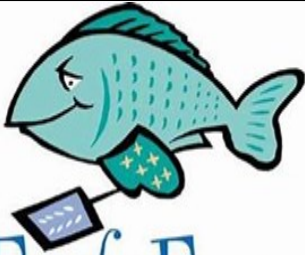
