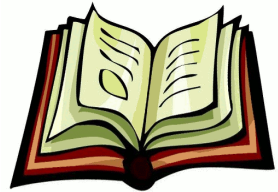

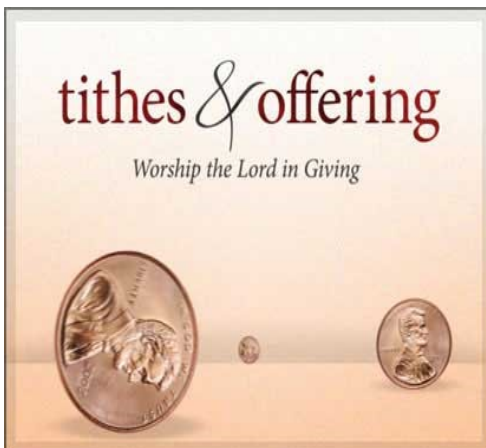
### “The Coronavirus”
